VACCINES NOW AVAILABLE

The State of Alabama announced Feb. 8 essential manufacturing employees in the 1B category are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. The eligible 1B category includes Austal's workforce. That is, any on-site worker with an Austal branded badge including Austal employees, on-site contractors and sub-contractors, and Navy personnel.

Below is information on available providers in our area offering vaccines to the Austal workforce. Please bring your Austal badge for identification. These offsite appointments need to be scheduled outside of regular work hours.

We continue to work with local providers to establish a potential on-site vaccination location, however the quickest way for you to receive the vaccine is through one of the providers below.
